This group is now spread throughout the country and are over 100,000 in number. GOD IS AT WORK. In the near future we are believing God to see some greater things done by Him. Pray for us as we work in these communities with projects that will provide sustainability.

Colombia

Doors are opening in the city of Cali to serve and we are in the process of registering FCC there as a Foundation. Please pray that God will provide the right people to serve and lead. There are many people who are hungry for truth but are not getting it. There are several community projects that are in the process. This will help in making the work in Colombia fully sustainable. India

This year was an answer to prayer in the South parts of India. As you are aware, we have been stopped from all public evangelism but since it was an election year we were given permission to hold DVBS in several areas with hundreds of children in attendance. Zambia

There were nightly meetings where we saw many people come forward to receive Christ and some to recommit their lives to the Lord. With Allan and Floren McGuire being part of the team we had 750 Galcom solar powered radios distributed. Little things mean a lot to some people and my most precious moment was visiting an elderly woman who cried because we came to visit her. She said no one comes around in that area to
